Coming by Car

Highway A40 - coming from the **west** (Venlo, The Netherlands)

- Take exit No.11 named Duisburg-Homberg,
- Turn right – use Emmericher Straße,

Highway A40 – coming from the **east** (Duisburg Zentrum)

- Take exit No.11 named Duisburg-Homberg,
- Turn right – use Emmericher Straße,

Highway A3 – coming from the **north** (Arnhem, The Netherlands)

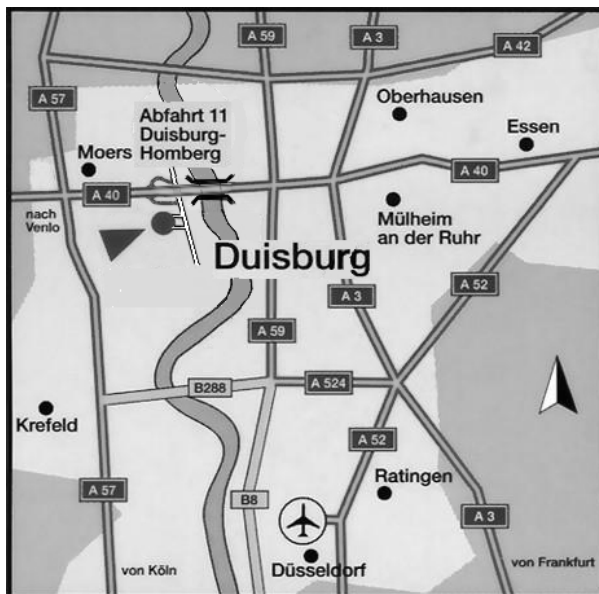
- Highway-Crossing ‚Kaiserberg‘ – take highway A40 direction Venlo,
- Take exit No.11 named Duisburg-Homberg,
- Turn right – use Emmericher Straße,

Highway A3 – coming from the **south** (Köln (Cologne))

- Highway-Crossing ‚Kaiserberg‘ – take highway A40 direction Venlo,
- Take exit No.11 named Duisburg-Homberg,
- Turn right – use Emmericher Straße,

follow the signs ‚Businesspark Niederrhein‘,

- Turn right (after 2nd traffic light) - use Dr.-Alfred-Herrhausen-Allee,
- The training centre is located on the right side (white building with yellow windows, No. 16), parking lot adjacent to the building.

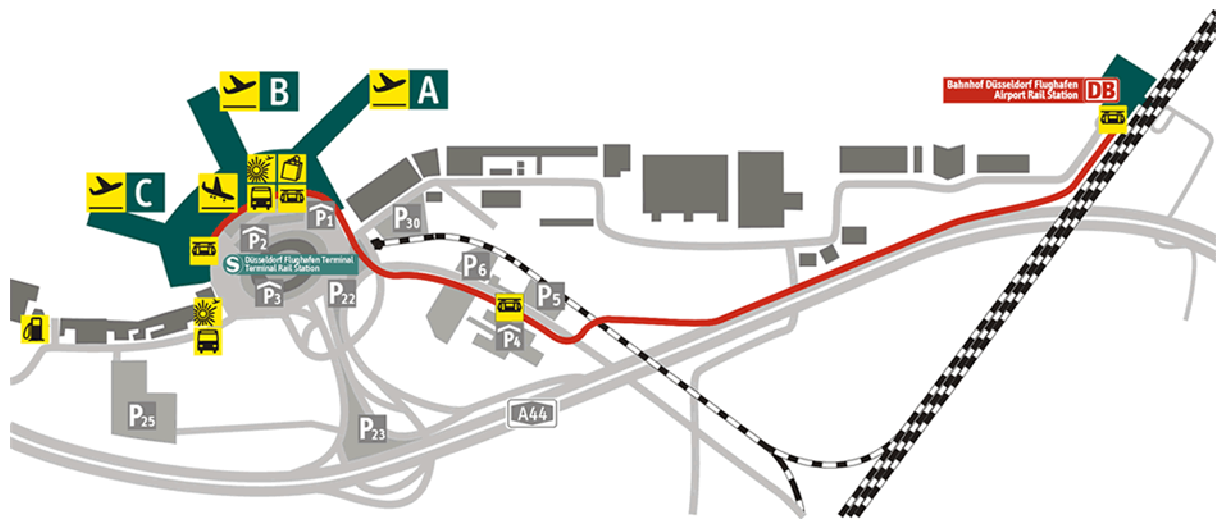


Coming by Train

- Leave the train at Duisburg Central Station (Duisburg Hauptbahnhof)
- Take the exit to the city (Innenstadt),
- Take a taxi to ‚Businesspark Niederrhein‘ (takes approx. 10 minutes)

Coming by Plane via Düsseldorf

- Leaving the terminal take the Skytrain to Airport Rail Station (DB)



- Take a train to Duisburg Central Station (Duisburg Hauptbahnhof)
- See ‚Coming by Train‘

Small Train-ABC for Foreigners

Trains from Airport Rail Station to Duisburg Central Station depart nearly every 15 minutes. There are information boards regarding the timetable at the Station. The yellow ones show the departure times (Abfahrt). The train ride takes about 10 to 12 minutes. There is no stop in between.

There are two types of trains existing:

1. Regional trains (Regionalexpress (RE))

The regional trains RE1, RE3 and RE11 are going to Duisburg Central Station. You have to buy a ticket in advance. Ticket can be bought at the Airport Rail Station at an automatic ticket counter. At the ticket counter you have to look up the number for Duisburg HBF and have to type it into the counter. The counter will ask for the money and after paying you will receive the ticket. At the entrance of the platform you have to stamp the ticket (little orange box called ‚Entwerter‘) to get it valid.

2. Long distance trains (IC or ICE)

A ticket can be bought on the train.

Coming by Car

- Coming from Highway A40 or Highway A3 go to Highway Crossing 'Duisburg-Kaiserberg' and take exit 'Kaiserberg',
- Follow direction 'Duisburg Zentrum' (Carl Benz Str.)
- Take first exit and turn right following direction 'Duisburg Zentrum' (Mülheimer Str.)
- Follow Mülheimer Straße straight ahead
- Approx. 300m after the tunnel the Mercure Duisburg City is situated at the left side

Coming by Train

- Leave Duisburg Central Station (Duisburg Hauptbahnhof) in direction 'Innenstadt'
- At the crossing turn right to direction 'Averdunk Center'
- Walk through the Center, at the end is the back entrance of Mercure Duisburg City
- Walking from the station to the hotel takes no longer than 5 minutes
